(plant orders due March 10)

Prices: Brook Trout and Rainbow Trout 6" to 8" are \$50 per one unit of 25 fish.
 Brook Trout and Rainbow Trout 10" to 12" are \$185 per one unit of 50 fish.
 Floating Trout Feed: 20 lbs. = \$20 40 lbs. = \$30 Knots Book \$8 each
 (Fish can not be mixed to meet minimum purchase units.)

Pick-up: For fish 6" to 8" (Bagged) **May 2nd , 12-12:30 PM**
Pick-Up Site **Picnic Rock Farm, Route #3 Meredith, NH** (map mailed with invoice)
 (Fish must be picked-up within the half-hour scheduled and released into your pond immediately)
Failure to pick-up fish on time results in forfeiture of order!


Pond Delivery: For fish 10" to 12" **Late April or Early May.**
Delivery date & time is at the discretion of the hatchery.
Please provide very detailed, written directions to your pond with your order form and payment. Include in directions: your name, town, mileage from turn-offs and intersections, road names, landmarks, and description of property.

The Belknap County Conservation District is taking orders for New Hampshire raised, disease free rainbow and brook trout. By ordering this spring your trout can adjust to your pond over the summer, and grow to become a tasty feast for you and your family. General guidelines for stocking your pond:

- A ¼ acre pond with a depth of 8 ft. that is full all summer with fresh water may support 100 fish
- Brook trout need cold water (approximately 45° to 60° F.)
- Rainbow trout tolerate warmer temperatures
- Best water pH range is 6 to 9
- The cleaner the water the better!
- Use of floating trout feed is recommended, especially for newer ponds
- New ponds should not be stocked until 1 year after construction
- Mixing of rainbow and brook trout is not recommended
- Place a screen at the pond's outlet to prevent trout from escaping
