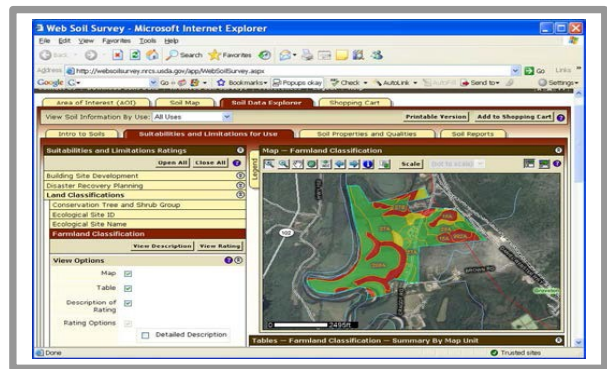

Web Soil Survey uses Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) soil survey maps to provide planners, conservation organizations, state agencies, educators, and landowners internet access to relevant soils information needed to make land use and management decisions. This workshop will explore the three easy steps to access a soil map for your "area of interest", create interpretive maps, review a variety of soils data and generate a customized report. Web Soil Survey is an alternative to the now outdated hardcopy publications to obtain the information you want.



The Aquatic Restoration Mapper is a tool to target stream restoration efforts and identify potential mitigation opportunities to improve stream connectivity, restore important fish habitats, and increase flood resiliency. The Mapper allows you to view data by town, watershed, or specific area of interest. You can explore and filter data, view photos, create maps and share results. Data includes, but not limited to, stream crossings, priority areas, species of concern, fish habitat, ranked wildlife habitat, land parcels, wetlands inventory, and flood hazard data.
