Item # Descriptions of Flowers Offered (see order form)

- **01 Dutch Master Daffodil** Excellent for large landscaping jobs. Classic daffodil silhouette. Fragrant. Deer resistant. Full to partial sun, well-drained soils. Blooms mid spring. Height (Ht): 16-18"; Hardiness Zone (HZ): 2-10.
- **02 Narcissus Bunch Flowering 'Sir Winston Churchill'** Each stem produces 3-4 creamy-white flowers with saffron-yellow centers. Highly fragrant. Full to partial sun. Blooms in mid-to-late-spring. Ht: 15-18"; HZ: 4-9.
- **03 Narcissus Butterfly 'Lemon Beauty'-** Split corona daffodil with upward facing white petals with a lemonyellow center. Slightly fragrant. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid-spring. Ht: 12-18"; HZ: 4-8.
- **04 Narcissus Double 'Ice King'** Large, full double blooms with ruffled lemon-yellow that fade to creamy white, resembling carnations. Slightly fragrant. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht: 16-18"; HZ: 3-9.
- **05 Narcissus Large Cupped 'Peaches and Cream'** Creamy-white petals surrounding a soft peach cup. Lightly fragrant. Tolerates heat and humidity well. Full sun to part shade. Blooms early to mid-spring. Ht: 16-18"; HZ: 3-8.
- **06 Narcissus Large Cupped 'Chromacolor'** Produces huge, 5" blooms with pure white petals with an extra wide deep coral cup. Lightly fragrant. Full sun to part shade. Blooms mid-spring. Ht: 16-20"; HZ: 3-8.
- **07 Narcissus Trumpet 'British Gamble'** Produces large, outward facing blooms with white petals and frilled coral-pink trumpet with a lemon-yellow throat. Full sun to part shade. Blooms mid-spring. Ht:16-18"; HZ: 3-8.
- **08** Muscari Grape Hyacinth Mixture Mix of various shades of blue, purple, and white for a dynamic spring display. Compact, bell-shaped flowers. Form dense clusters. Full-part sun. Bloom mid-late spring. Ht: 8"; HZ: 4-9.
- **09 Hyacinth 'Gypsy Princess'** Buttery yellow scented blooms. Good naturalizer. Prefers rich, well-drained soil. Long lasting. Deer resistant. Loved by pollinators. Blooms in early-mid spring. Full-partial sun. Ht:10-12"; HZ: 4-8.
- **10 Hyacinth 'Pink Surprise'** Densely packed spikes of soft baby pink florets. Delightfully fragrant. Early-season nectar source for pollinators. Blooms in early to mid-spring. Partial shade to full sun. Ht: 8-12"; HZ: 4-8.
- 11 Crocus Large Flowering Mix 'Blue Moon'- Large blooms about 3" in size. Colors may consist of purple, blue, and white. Blooms early spring. Prefers full sun. Deer resistant. Attracts pollinators! Ht: 4-6"; HZ: 3-8.
- **12 Crocus Tommasinianus 'Ruby Giant'** Deep violet-purple, star shaped blooms with bright orange anthers. Spreads vigorously and returns reliably each year. Blooms early spring. Full sun to partial shade. Ht: 4-6"; HZ: 3-8.
- 13 Wild Hyacinth/ Quamash- Tapering spikes of star-shaped, deep blue florets. Hardy. Full-partial sun. Prefers moist, well-drained soils. AKA Camas Lily or Indian Hyacinth. Native to northwestern U.S. Ht: 28"; HZ: 4-8.
- **14 Chionodoxa (Glory of the Snow) 'Luciliae Alba'** Dainty white star-shaped flowers in loose clusters of up to 8 blooms per stem. Good for naturalizing, woodland edges, and borders. Blooms early spring. Ht: 3-6" HZ: 4-10
- **15 Anenome Coronaria 'Mr. Fokker'** Hardy perennial that features vivid, velvety purple-blue blooms with dark button center. Deer resistant and attracts butterflies. Good in containers. Full-partial sun. Ht.: 10-16" HZ: 4-8
- **16 Mini-Allium 'Ping Pong'-** Soft pink blooms that transition to bright white. 2" spherical flower heads. Bloom late spring-early summer. Drought-tolerant. Deer resistant. Attracts butterflies. Full partial sun. Ht.: 20-24" HZ: 4-7
- **17 Tulip Darwin Hybrid 'World Peace'** Large, cup-shaped deep magenta blooms with golden-yellow edges. Flowers reach up to 5" across. Blooms mid-spring. Full partial sun. Ht: 20-24"; HZ: 3-7.
- **18 Tulip Single Early 'Hermitage'** Bold orange petals with deep red flames. Traditional tulip shape with 4-5" diameter blooms. Blooms in mid-late spring. Well-drained soils. Full sun to mostly sunny. Ht: 14-16"; HZ: 3-8.
- **19 Tulip Triumph 'Ronaldo'** Deep maroon-purple blooms with a smoky sheen, almost appearing black. Blooms mid-late spring. Prized for its weather resistance and forcing suitability. Sun to mostly sunny. Ht: 18-20"; HZ: 3-8.
- **20 Tulip Parrot 'Silver Parrot'** Showstopper known for its large, ruffled petals in silvery pink with creamy white edges. Flattens out revealing more color as it matures. Blooms late spring. Full-partial sun. Ht: 14-16"; Hz: 3-8.
- **21 Tulip Fringed 'Crystal Star'**—Pure yellow blooms with delicately fringed petal edges. Sturdy stems supporting flowers up to 4" across. Blooms in mid-late spring. Full to partial sun. Ht: 16-18"; HZ: 3-8.
- **22 Tulip Lily Flowering 'Lasting Love'**–Deep burgundy petals that fade to softer red edges. Slightly recurved petals. Standout in gardens and floral arrangements. Blooms in late spring. Full to partial sun. Ht: 22"; HZ: 3-8.
- 23 Tulip Double Late 'Carnival de Nice'- Densely packed white blooms streaked with burgundy-red. Sturdy stems support 4" flowers. Variegated leaves with white margins. Blooms in late spring. Full sun. Ht: 20"; HZ: 3-8.

24 Siberian Squill 'Spring Beauty'–Nodding, bell-shaped flowers in intense blue hues with 2-5 blooms per stem. Naturalizes easily. Winter hardy. Deer resistant. Full sun to part shade. Blooms early spring. Ht: 6-8"; HZ: 3-9.

25 Leucojum Giant Snowflake 'Gravetye Giant'-Summer snowflake with white flowers and green-tipped tepals. Mild chocolate scent. Prefers moist, well-drained soils. Bloom mid-late spring. Full to part sun. Ht: 20-24"; HZ: 4-8.

26 Fritillaria Meleagris Mix (Checkered Lily)—Bell shaped blooms in deep purple, pink, and white. Naturalizes and often used in borders. Prefers humus-rich, moist, well drained soils. Thrives in part shade. Ht: 9-12"; HZ: 3-8.

27 Bearded Iris 'Nice Job' – Orange beards provide bold contrast with lemon-yellow standards and purple infused midribs; flaring falls are deep purple with hazelnut. Late-mid season blooms. Full-part sun. Ht: 32"; HZ: 3-10.

28 Bearded Iris 'Pagan Dance' – Rebloomer with violet standards that contrast with velvety black-violet falls. Late summer-early fall blooms. Prefers slightly alkaline pH. Deer resistant. Full-part sun. Ht: 30-32"; HZ: 3-10.

29 Giant Allium 'Ambassador'- Towering ornamental onion with 6-8" flowers. Long lasting as cut flowers. Some drought tolerance. Deer resistant. Blooms late spring to early summer. Full to part sun. Ht: 36-48". HZ: 4-8.

30 Virginia Bluebells – Hardy perennial native to the eastern U.S. Delicate looking pink buds open to porcelain blue bell-shaped flowers. Early nectar source. Blooms mid-spring. Part-full shade. Ht: 24-30"; HZ: 3-8.

31 Hardneck Garlic 'German Extra Hardy'-The large size of the cloves helps with overwintering. 4-6 plump cloves per head. Stores well. Full sun and well-drained soil. Ready in spring for scapes and summer for cloves.
