Item #	Descriptions of Flowers Offered	(see order form)
01 Dutch Master Daffodil	- Excellent for large landscaping jobs. Great for pollinators! Fragrant. Deer & rodent resistant. Full to partial sun. Blooms in April. Ht.: 14-16". HZ: 2-10.	
02 Narcissus Large Cupped 'Accent'	-Sun-proof naturalizer with 4" flowers of ivory-white around a frilled light salmon- ink funnel. A good forcer. Blooms April. Ht:18-20" HZ 3-7	
03 Narcissus Miniature 'Jetfire'	- Vivid yellow and a strong orange trumpet. One of the most celebrated naturalizing early bloomers. Blooms in April. Ht:8-10" HZ 3-8	
04 Narcissus Split Corona 'Butterfly Mix'	-Stunning double centers, stripes, and frills that often resemble a butterfly. Deer resistant. Fragrant. Blooms mid-spring. Ht: 14-16" HZ: 2-10	
05 Spring Starflower (Ipheion) 'Jessie'	- The darkest blue of all the Ipheion. Flowers bloom for at least 8 weeks. Deer resistant. Blooms early to mid-spring. Full to part sun. Ht: 6-10" HZ 5-9	
06 Hyacinth 'Pink Pearl'	-A dense pink spike of fragrant florets surrounded by green sword-like foliage. Hardy, deer resistant. Blooms mid-spring. Full to partial sun. Ht: 10-12" HZ: 2-10	
07 Hyacinth 'Aida'	-Violet-blue/purple scented flowers with green, glossy leaves. Perfect for displays, borders, containers and cut flowers. Prefers well-drained soil. Blooms early-mid spring. Deer, rodent, and rabbit resistant. Pollinator friendly. Partial shade to full sun. Ht: 8-12". HZ: 4-8.	
08 Lebanon Squill	- Delicate white petals with blue veins. Great at naturalizing. Full to partial sun. Blooms early spring. Ht.: 4-6" HZ: 3-10.	
09 Crocus Saffron 'Sativus'	-These beautiful purple crocus flower in fall and offer you edible saffron on each flower's stigmas. Easy to grow and exceptional in containers. Ht 6-12" HZ 5-8	
10 Large Flowering Crocus Mix	- Large blooms @ 3" in size. Colors white, yellow, & purple. Blooms early spring. Full sun-partial shade. Deer resistant. Attracts pollinators. Ht: 4-6" HZ: 3-9.	
11 Tulip Single Early 'Flair'	- Red tulip with yellow petal with brilliant red up center. Cup shaped blooms with strong stems to withstand wind and rain. Blooms in early spring. Best grown in well-drained soils, full sun to part shade. Ht: 10-14" HZ: 3-10.	
12 Tulip Single Late 'Helmar'	- Striking two-toned tulip yellow in color with big, dark red flames. Tallest tulip variety with elegant large flower heads on tall stems. Great choice for containers. Blooms in late spring. Ht: 24" HZ: 3-9.	
13 Tulip Double Late 'Foxtrot'	- Petals with soft white line in center which turns blush pink with rose pink slightly ruffled edges, similar to a peony. Great for borders, sunny patio pot, or cut flowers. Blooms in late spring planted in full to partial sun. Ht: 16-18" HZ: 2-8.	
14 Tulip Parrot 'Parrot King'	- Golden yellow blossoms brushed with dark orange, rose and green. Petal edges are crimped and feathered with exotic appeal. Easy to grow, blooms planted in late spring in sun to part shade. Great for borders or containers. Plant in groups (10-15 bulbs) for best visual impact. Ht: 18-20" HZ: 3-7.	
15 Tulip Greigii 'Red Riding Hood'	- Dramatic scarlet blooms with black base and deeper red outside petals. Leaves are variegated with green and purple. Perfect for rock gardens, borders, containers, and mixed with daffodils. Boom mid-spring planted in full sun. Ht: 10-12" HZ: 2-8.	
16 Glory of the Snow (Chionodoxa) 'Violet Beauty'	- Deer resistant, easy to grow and a great naturalizer. One of the first flowers to bloom in early spring. Full -part sun. Ht.: 6-10" HZ: 2-8.	

17 Dutch Iris Mix - Blooms mid-late spring. Makes nice cut flowers that last long in a vase. Easy to establish and often used in borders. Deer resistant. Full – part sun. Ht 20-24” HZ 5-10
18 Grape Hyacinth (Muscari) ‘Valerie Finnis’ – Accommodating, simple to grow, durable. Ideal companions for taller bulbs or flowering shrubs. Produces a cluster of light blue flowers with delightful fragrance. Blooms mid-late spring. Prefers well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Reduce watering after foliage dies back. Ht. 6-8” HZ 4-8.
19 Frittilaria Mix – Blend of purple flowers from pink to plum mixed with white. Excellent naturalizer in woodlands or meadows, prefers rich, moist soil in part shade. Bulbs have faint skunky smell which repels pests including voles. Ht. 9-12” HZ 4-8.
20 Snowdrops Double (Galanthus) ‘Flore Pleno’ - Early flowering bulbs, often popping through the snow. Double white flowers. Ideal naturalizer. Grow well under deciduous trees. Deer resistant. Bloom late winter-very early spring. Full-part sun. Ht: 4-6”. HZ: 3-7
21 Anemone Blanda Mix (Windflowers) - Great mix of pink, white and blue with daisy-like blossoms in early spring. Ideal planted with hyacinth and tulips. Recommend soaking bulbs in warm water for a few hours before planting. Full sun to part sun. Ht: 6-8”. HZ: 5-9.
22 Allium Miniature ‘Azureum’ - Also known as caeruleum. Unusual flax-blue flower heads, resulting in a 1-2” sphere. Fragrant. Great for pollinators! Deer & rodent resistant. Full sun. Blooms early summer, June-July. Ht: 14-16”. HZ: 2-10.
23 Allium Giant ‘Pinball Wizard’ – Striking silver lilac flowers, great for smaller gardens or front of the border. Excellent for perennial gardens and containers. Attracts bees and butterflies, deer resistant. Full sun in well-drained, sandy soil. Blooms in late spring. Ht: 24-32” HZ: 3-8.
24 Iris Tall Bearded ‘All Night Long’ – Late bloom. Dark purple-black, slightly sweet fragrant iris. Drought tolerant. Deer resistant. Full -part sun. Blooms mid-late spring. Ht: 24-36”. HZ: 3-10
25 Iris Tall Bearded ‘Grand Canyon Sunset’ – Brilliant apricot standards contrasting pale, lavender purple falls. Profuse bloomer. Drought tolerant. Deer resistant. Full - part sun. Blooms late spring- early summer Good for cut flowers. Ht: 24-36”. HZ: 3-9.
26 Hardneck Garlic ‘Music’ - Music is a Porcelain variety prized for its huge cloves, medium spiciness, and easy-to-peel wrappers. The large size of the cloves helps with overwintering (great for Northeast growers) and gives plants the energy they need in spring. 4-6 plump cloves per head. Stores well. Full sun and well-drained soil. Ready in spring for scapes and summer for cloves. Ht: 24-30”.
27 Bulb Fertilizer – A long-acting, all-natural fertilizer. 3 lb. bag will cover 60 sq ft “4-4-2” variety
